



Your Sampler's license\permit will expire on March 31, 2009.

Sampling in connection with receiving, buying, or paying for milk and/or cream without a valid Sampler's license is a violation of Section 10 of the Creamery License Law.

Please complete the enclosed application form and return it with the required license fee of \$10.00. Please note that failure to submit the required fee for a period of greater than 30 days will result in a late fee of the greater of \$5.00 or 10%.

If you no longer wish to sample milk and/or cream under the Indiana Creamery License Law and consequently have no need for a valid sampler's license, please send a letter informing me of your decision.

To ensure that every person is doing their absolute best at sampling, agitating, weighing, and determining the quality of the milk on the farm, I am enclosing a Hauler Schedule form I would like you to complete to the best of your knowledge. I understand that things change sometimes, the time of pick up, the farms on your route, the plant you take it to, etc. What I am asking for is the basic schedule you follow during any given week.

I will be making random stops at any farm to check up on everyone. I want to do the best at my job so that you can do the best at yours.

You will find a sample of how I would like you to fill the sheet out. Please have every milk hauler fill out a sheet.
